- a. All first Year and Fourth Year undergraduate, Postgraduate, Diploma and Certificate students to report on 15th April, 2024.
- b. All second Year and Third Year students to report on 29th April, 2024.
- c. All TVET students to report on 8th April, 2024 to begin registration for National Examinations.

Kindly note that all students should meet the following conditions for readmission to the University:

- a. To register at their respective schools for readmission, failure to which they will be deregistered from the students' portal (UNIPLUS)
- b. Sign the code of conduct form upon readmission into the University. (The form is to be downloaded online and filled before returning for admission)
- c. Each student to pay a penalty of Ksh.2,100/= for damages incurred by the University during the students unrest before readmission into the University.
- d. All students to clear the required fee balances before readmission into the University.
- e. All Postgraduate and ODeL students are exempted from penalties for damages incurred by the University during the students' unrest.

NOTE: That all students are required to present their national ID cards or Birth Certificate (for underage students only) for registration in their respective Schools.
